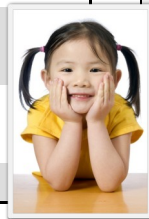

DROP-OFF & PICK-UP

Parents' Night Out begins promptly at 6:00 PM.

We will be available only at this time to check you in. Children must be picked up no later than 9:30 p.m. Unless other arrangements have been made with the program director, the parent/guardian who checks in the child must pick them up afterwards. Please bring a valid photo I.D. in the event you are asked to present it at drop-off or pick-up. A \$10 late fee will be charged for every 15-minute interval after 9:30PM.

Members may participate in one Parents' Night Out session per month.

GUIDELINES

Registration Begins at 1:01 a.m. on the Monday prior to the program, and is open to YMCA members only. Registrations are accepted in person or online at www.ymcashr.org. Registrations are not accepted by phone. You may not register another member's child. Members may only participate in one Parents' Night Out session per month. If you experience problems with online registration, please notify us.

Waiting List When age groups are filled, a waiting list begins. Last-minute cancellations occur, and we contact members on the waiting list in the order they were registered. If a space becomes available, we will call you by 3:00pm the day of the event.

Clothing & Shoes Children must wear closed-toe shoes to participate. Parents must provide an extra change of dry clothes. Appropriate swim wear is required for pool use.

Dinner A pizza dinner and drink is provided for the children. Please notify us of any food allergies upon registration.

Behavior Children are expected to abide by all rules and use appropriate behavior and language during this program. If a child repeatedly uses inappropriate language or behavior after being warned, the parent will be called to pick up the child immediately. **All children must be fully potty-trained and able to use the restroom unassisted.**

Cancellations If you must cancel, please do so as early as possible so your child's space may be offered to another child. Failure to cancel before the start of the program may result in loss of registration privileges for the next session.

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY - We must have a valid phone number where the parent/guardian can be reached at ALL TIMES.
